Admin/Bio History

Royal Barry Wills (1895 – 1962) opened his architectural office in Boston in 1925 focusing on residential architecture. He published eight books on architecture. In 1957 his firm became Royal Barry Wills Associates.

Scope and Content

The items include plans for residential homes in Wellesley, Massachusetts and a Proposed Scheme for Wellesley Historical Society Building, drawn in 1963. The buildings in the collection are identifiable by owner's name. Robert Minot who worked at Royal Barry Wills Architects in the 1950's drew many of the plans in the collection.
