## **Administrative History**

*The Townsman*, a weekly paper published in Wellesley Massachusetts, published its first issue on April 6, 1906. Originally published on Friday afternoons, it was devoted entirely to the town of Wellesley and its interests: religious, educational, political and social welfare. In the early years, the editor requested submissions for current news, lodge and club meeting notes, society events, and personals.

*The Townsman* was not the first newspaper to be published in Wellesley. *The Wellesley Courant* was published from 1883 until around the end of 1895, and *The Wellesley Review* was published from 1893 until about 1906. However, the precursor to *The Townsman*, was a modest monthly periodical, *Our Town*, which was first published January 1898. Originally focused on moral and religious problems and activities, it quickly broadened its scope to the discussion of all kinds of town issues. *Our Town* ran for six years, during which time it became increasingly evident that a weekly paper would be of great value to the community. However, by the end of 1903, with the dissolution of *Our Town*, a movement had been started in the Wellesley Club for the establishment of a local weekly paper. The matter was discussed, resulting in the following circular which was sent out to residents:

The Town of Wellesley needs a good weekly newspaper, directed by its townspeople and devoted wholly to the interest of the Town. The public welfare will in many ways be served by the establishment of such a publication, properly presenting the news and interests of the community. This can now be done if sufficient public interest is shown...We feel that this enterprise has in it the possibility of great value to the Town, and commend it to your careful consideration (*The Townsman*, vol. 1, no. 1).

The response to the circular was positive; however, arrangements could not be made at the time for a creation of a paper. The issue of a local paper was brought up again, and the Wellesley Publishing Company was formed. A circular was sent out to residents after the incorporation of the Wellesley Publishing Company stating "The Town of Wellesley is to have a weekly newspaper directed by its townspeople and devoted to the interests of the Town…the enterprise is regarded more in the nature of a public benefit than an enterprise for profit…" (*The Townsman*, vol. 1, no. 1). The company's board included: Isaac Sprague-President, C.N. Taylor-Treasurer, George A. Sweetser-Clerk, J.W. Peabody and W.O. Robson-Directors, and John T. Ryan-Editor and Manager.

The Townsman continues to be published on a weekly basis, and is available in print and online.

#### **Scope and Content**

This collection contains the issues from *The Townsman*, beginning with the first issue April 6, 1906 through April 6, 2006, in unbound form; and from 1906-1978 in bound form. Every attempt has been made to keep the four best unbound copies; unfortunately, in many instances, four copies were not available. In some cases, entire years are missing in both bound and unbound form.

In addition to the regular issues, *The Townsman* published occasional supplements. These include the Servicemen's Pictorial issues, which ran annually every spring from 1943-1945. Conceived by the editor, A. Edwin "Buck" Larson, it became an annual feature for the men and women in the armed forces. It was also the first such effort on the part of either a daily or weekly paper in the country (*The Townsman*, Feb. 23, 1945).

Other supplements published with the paper include: the Student Special which was published in the fall, and would become the Back to School insert; the Special Pictorial section which ran from March 3, 1939-March 31, 1939; Guide to Shopping published in May 16, 1957; "Buy in Wellesley" published May 17, 1967; "At the Playhouse" published December 11, 1968; the Newcomer's Guide "Welcome to Wellesley"; "A Day in the Life of Wellesley"; Centennial Anniversary Issue" published April 2, 1981; "Official Guide to Wellesley's Veterans Parade" published in October 14, 1990; "Town of Wellesley Net Valuation of Personal Property and Real Estate, and Tax Rate" published in January 9, 1992; "Celebrating 125 Years of Wellesley College" published in April 2001; and "Wellesley: Celebrating 125 Years, 1881-2006" published April 6, 2006.

The collection also includes 56 reels of microfilm, covering the years 1906-1965.

### System of Arrangement

The newspapers are organized chronically; the unbound issues are separated from the bound volumes.

## **Immediate Source of Acquisition**

The majority of the collection does not have any acquisition information. A number of unbound issues are stamped "Wellesley Free Library"; however, only six of these stamped issues have accession information. In 1983, the Wellesley Free Library donated those six issues, from 1907 to 1915, to the Historical Society (1983.58). The following additional issues were donated to the Wellesley Historical Society: April 3, 1931 was donated by Agnes E. Dodge in May 1957 (D.4), May 24, 1956 was donated by Mrs. Hetty S. Wheeler on September 14, 1959 (W.28).

17 reels of microfilm covering issues from January 1908 to December 1924 were purchased by the Wellesley Historical Society on December 7, 1968 from an unnamed source (1968.101). An additional 39 reels of microfilm covering issues from April 6, 1906 to December 1965 were

purchased by the Wellesley Historical Society on March 24, 1969 from another unnamed source (1969.18).

The Wellesley Historical Society may add additional materials to the collection in the future; however, no further accruals are currently expected.
